Syllable Clapping

Warm up: Ask an adult to clap out a pattern using up to 6 claps. Practice copying this pattern. Start small using 2 or 3 claps at different speeds and then increase the amount when you feel confident.

Challenge – Clap out some words to see how many parts they have. We call these parts syllables and some have just one but some words have lots.

1 syllable	2 syllables	3 syllables	4 syllables
