

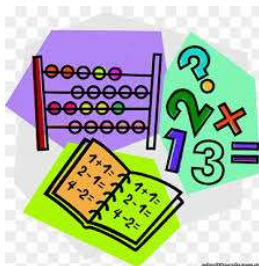


Parkhead PS - Welcome back P3a Newsletter

We will also continue to work closely on recognising common words by sight and reading strategies to develop reading fluency.



Numeracy - This term in numeracy we will be focusing on number structure and place value strategies using a mixture of concrete, pictorial and abstract strategies.

We will also be looking at 2D and 3D shape.
