How have we spent our first few weeks?

Literacy- This term we will continue to work on learning new spelling strategies through our letter sounds using our Jolly Phonics programme to help us read and spell new words. We will be looking at the features of narrative writing through our PM writing program. We will also continue to work closely on recognising common words by sight and reading strategies to develop reading fluency.





Numeracy- This term in numeracy we will be focusing on number structure and place value strategies using a mixture of concrete, pictorial and abstract strategies. We will also be looking at properties of 2D and 3D shapes.
