# How have we spent our first few weeks?

### Literacy-

The class has carried out work on noun types and adjectives within grammar. These topics have helped the children prepare and work toward the 'descriptive writing' genre, which will be our main focus this term. In reading, we began working with the reciprocal reading approach -looking at one of the four strategies: 'clarifying'. The Reciprocal reading approach aims to improve children's reading comprehension skills.





#### Numeracy-

In P5 we have been revisiting place values and partitioning with numbers up to 10,000. We have also been comparing and ordering whole numbers. This involved using the symbols 'greater than' and 'less than'. The class enjoys the variety of lessons and the outdoor learning. The class has also been working on their times tables (weekly) and good progress is being made.
