

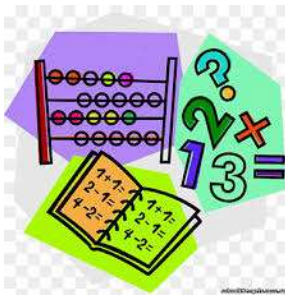


## Parkhead PS - Welcome back P7A Newsletter

Literacy- We have been learning about Parts of Speech, which includes: nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, adverbial phrases and fronted adverbials. We did a reading comprehension all about the origins of the Olympic Games and that was really interesting. Numeracy- We have been focusing on Place Value, looking at numbers up to ten million. We have been ordering and comparing these larger numbers, putting them in ascending and descending order. We have also worked on extending number lines, working out the values and estimating where numbers would be placed on the number lines. Today we have been rounding to the nearest power of 10.
