In the story, each animal's name starts with the same letter as its vehicle. Can you use <u>alliteration</u> like this to draw another animal in a vehicle?

In the story, the cheetah is the fastest animal on land. Could you colour in your own cheetah mask? Does wearing the mask help you to run any faster?

# Find yourself in a Map


Explore your favourite places on Google Maps. Use the street view function to see if you can see your house, your school or your favourite landmarks in the world!
