News from inside the classroom

We have been learning:

Maths: We have been learning to Multiply by 1, 2 or even 3 digits. As with all maths, this has been easy for some but difficult for others. (Ayla) We've explored different methods, like the lattice method as well as formal algorithms. We investigated square numbers and prime numbers to help us with our multiplication. (Lucas) We also learned about decimals in the place value system and how to carry out calculations which include these. (Holly) For Data Handling, we combined Anti-Bullying Week with Maths. We created online surveys for staff and pupils, collected, displayed and analysed information about bullying in Parkhead. (Denis) We found out that all the way through the school, there needs to be more clarity about what Bullying actually is.

Literacy: We've been looking at how to structure Information Reports. We discovered 5 different paragraph structures to help us organise and present our information. We learned about topic sentences — their purpose and how to write them. (Mia)

Health & Well-being: This month we have been learning strategies for Keeping Myself Safe. We watched some scenarios to help us understand how to deal with some scary situations that we could find ourselves in. (Eilidh and Orla) We reminded ourselves about the different strategies that we could apply.

Social Studies: We really enjoyed learning all about WW2. We had so many questions — most of which we've been able to answer. We used this as the basis for our Assembly. (Harrison) **Expressive Arts**: In December we did our School Show auditions for Wonderland, a musical adaptation of Alice in Wonderland. We are all very excited to take part in the show.
