The VSE is a crucial exercise where the school and ELC, in collaboration with Local Authority Education Officers and visiting head teachers, rigorously examines its performance and effectiveness. It is a process designed to support and challenge our work, ensuring we are constantly focused on improving the quality of provision and achieving the best outcomes for every learner. We are extremely proud that the external validation team confirmed our own selfevaluation judgements, reflecting the hard work and dedication of our entire school community.

### Investing in Every Child: Our PEF Focus for 2025-26

We are committed to providing equal opportunities for all children. Our Pupil Equity Funding (PEF) for the 2025-2026 session is focused on reducing barriers and enhancing wellbeing. Based on parent feedback, we will subsidise the School Camp and actively reduce the cost of other trips to ensure all pupils can participate. We've introduced a 'Bussers Breakfast Club' to ensure every child starts the day with a healthy meal, removing financial barriers. Targeted support funding will provide Additional Staff for nurturing interventions, and specific pupils will benefit from Music Therapy to improve wellbeing and attendance, and Kids Gone Wild sessions to boost resilience.
