News from inside our classroom

The children have settled into school life really well this term. We are familiar with our classroom routines and it is lovely to see how much everyone is growing in confidence. In literacy, we've learned all the letters of the alphabet, we are now focusing on their letter sounds, letter names and are using these sounds to read and spell words. We are also learning about digraphs (two letters that make one sound e.g. ai). In reading we have been reading lots of books together and have been developing our reading skills. We have also been learning some tricky words. In numeracy, we have been counting, recognising, and writing numbers and are also learning to add and subtract. This term we learned about Firework Safety in the lead up to Bonfire Night. The children were very excited to share their experiences of this and were keen to share their safety tips with each other! They also created bonfire artwork with Ms Mackie in art. In science, we've been learning about our Five Senses and why they are important. We went on a Senses Walk and recorded what we saw, heard, felt and smelled.
