We really enjoyed our extreme earth topic – we learned about tsunamis, volcanoes, earthquakes and tornados. In numeracy and maths, we were learning about place value and measure. We learned about hundreds, tens and ones and how to partition 3 digit numbers. We also learned how to measure in metres, centimetres and millimetres. In literacy, we learned how to write a procedure and we learned about lots of word attack strategies to help us read fluently.



Looking forward to Term 2

Our topic this term is renewable and non-renewable energy. So far we have been learning about hydropower and wind turbines. We labelled them and researched information. In numeracy and maths, we have been skip counting in 7s and 9s and we will be using this to learn about the 7 and 9 times tables. We will also be learning about 2D and 3D shape. In literacy, we are learning to write an explanation and continuing to work on strategies to help us clarify a text.
