Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to inform you that we have received more details about our upcoming competition and can inform you that the Glee Team will be performing at the Alhambra Theatre in Dunfermline on **Thursday 19th March 2026**.

The competition takes place after school from 6-8.30pm, with doors opening to parents and families from 5.30pm. You are warmly invited to attend and support the pupils on what promises to be a fantastic evening. Tickets are not yet on sale but we will be in touch with further information and a link with how and where to purchase as soon as they become available.

On the day of the performance (Thursday 19th March), pupils will remain in school after finishing time, as transport will be provided. The bus will depart from **West Calder High School at 3.30pm**. As this will be a long day, please ensure your child brings a 'packed tea' and drink with them to take to the theatre. On arrival at the theatre, we will have time to get settled and eat our packed tea before taking to the stage to perform!

The performance is expected to finish at approximately **8.30-8.45pm**, with the return journey taking around 40minutes. We anticipate pupils will be ready for collection from **West Calder High between 9.15pm-9.45pm**.
